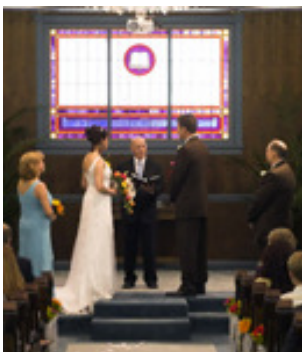

UNITY ON GREENVILLE



Congratulations on your decision to make this important commitment! We send you our love and blessings for a rich, loving relationship.

Unity on Greenville could well be the ideal place for your wedding or commitment ceremony. Our inclusive policy respects the diversity of society, welcoming all people regardless of religious affiliation or sexual orientation. We offer positive, spiritual, non-denominational ceremonies and a peaceful, inspirational environment for a very reasonable price.

Unity honors all spiritual and religious paths. We attract many couples who do not have a regular church home, or for some reason cannot be married in their own church. Membership in Unity or attending a Unity class is *not* required, although we do invite you to check us out on a Sunday (9:30 class or 11:00 a.m. service).

ORIENTATION MEETING: Except for informal ceremonies, couples must meet with the minister prior to the ceremony. This meeting usually lasts about 30-45 minutes and is held to go over the ceremony, complete financial arrangements and answer questions. This is not pre-marital counseling. Basic pre-marital counseling is available by request on a love offering basis.

OTHER MINISTERS: Couples may provide a different minister of their own choosing to officiate. However, our minister fee will still apply.

| <p>This ceremony is by far our most popular. It is ideally suited for either the formal or semi-formal wedding. A Unity Candle Lighting ceremony with candelabra is available. Up to 200 guests may attend. Time Allotted: 2.5 hours (1 hour prior, 30 minute ceremony and 1 hour after wedding time)</p> <p>Church Fee: \$ 400 Minister's Fee: \$ 325 Total Cost: \$ 725 Deposit Required: \$ 200</p> |

DEPOSIT: We reserve your ceremony date once your deposit is received. (See Ceremony Packages above for amount required.) The remaining balance is due 3 weeks prior to your ceremony.

MARRIAGE LICENSES: A Texas marriage license is required for all weddings. Please bring your license to the church prior to your ceremony. For information about obtaining a marriage license, please contact: 214-653-7099 (Dallas County), 817-884-1111 (Tarrant County) or 972-434-7100 (Denton County).

RECEPTIONS: Receptions may be held in our Upper Room located in the church facility. A kitchen is available for your use. Wine and Champagne are allowed during the reception only. You are responsible for leaving the area in the condition in which you found it. The bridal party needs to remove all items such as shoe boxes, plastic wraps, hangers, etc. Caterers must clean up after themselves. Red punch is not allowed.

DECORATIONS: Our sanctuary is decorated with silk flower bouquets at no additional charge. Couples may decorate the sanctuary themselves as long as it is in good taste. Decorating and flower delivery may be done 1 hour prior to the ceremony for a Simple Wedding and 2 hours prior to a Standard one.

Removal of furniture must be approved by the minister or a representative of the church. No wire or tape can be used on the pews (ribbons, rubber bands or pipe cleaners are recommended). Couples must provide their own dripless candles.

Please note: All decorations, flower boxes and trash must be removed from the church following the wedding.

PARKING: There is no parking adjacent to the church. Parking on Greenville can be a challenge especially after 6:00 p.m. Parking is allowed in the strip center across the street from the church, on the South side of the street on McCommas and various other side streets. Parking is not allowed in BlueFish or Kirby's parking lot across the street. **Automobiles will be towed.**

THROWING OF RICE is not permitted. Birdseed may be used outside of the church. Bubbles are recommended.

CANCELLATIONS: A full refund will be given if a cancellation occurs more than 60 days prior to the ceremony date. Refunds after 60 days are at the discretion of the church.
